Tow privileged this generation is

to bear witness to ancient Prophecies that are coming to pass, as foretold by Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Isaiah, Zechariah and others, G-d's mighty Hand is stretched out over the vast Valley of Dry Bones in the Diaspora, and those with ears turned to understanding can hear the rattling. Indeed, the Holy One is causing the House of Israel, the Exiled Remnant, who cried out: "Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost; we are clean cut off?" to be reunited with Eretz Yisra'el. While the Jewish People again plant the soles of their feet upon their Biblical Inheritance. what was once a barren Land, clothed in sackcloth and covered with dust, is today a revived Homeland, bringing forth fruit from Her moss-green valleys and tree-covered hills. Even the desert is blossoming. What's more, craftsmen are in the Land building up Zion to the dismay of the nations, which are being drawn by a Divine Hook to the Valley of Decision

While the End of Days continues to unfold amid a host of powerful delusions, every one of G-d's servants should be soberly anticipating – expecting and preparing for – the culmination of Redemption. For those who are, those who have set their faces toward Jerusalem; who have fixed their minds upon G-d's Covenant Promises, and who earnestly champion the fulfillment of His Redemptive Plan, an unprecedented opportunity for righteousness beckons:

On the hills of Hebron, the Nir College of Judaic Studies, an Orthodox hesder Yeshiva in Kiryat Arba, promoting Torah study, military readiness, and the settling of Eretz Yisra'el, is welcoming Christians and other Bible believers who seek to support the Biblical Process of Zionism – the building up of the Land and the Re-gathering of the Remnant. It was in response to unexpected and overwhelming expressions of solidarity from Christian visitors to Kiryat Arba's Jewish community that Nir College has developed a pioneering program called Project Shofar to facilitate this Divine Process. Today, the project is undertaking the mitzvah of expanding this exceptional Torah institution, where the Word of G-d is taught to the next generation of Jewish leaders:

Imbued with the pioneering spirit, the Yeshiva has been the backbone of the Zionist Process since its inception shortly after the Six-Day War in 1967, which saw the return of much of the ancient heartland to the Jewish People. Seeking to seize the miracle of the moment, a small Remnant resolutely set out for the very first Jewish City and set up camp in what was once King Hussein's stables, and for two arduous years they toiled to restore Jewish life to Hebron. Nir College, founded in 1968, was one of the fruits of their labors. What was once a tiny shack upon a barren Judaean hilltop is today a sprawling campus, which is home to the only Yeshiva in the Land that was established by a decision of the Israeli government. The now thriving suburban town of Kiryat Arba rose up around the college. Overseeing this fine establishment is one of the original founders: Rosh Yeshiva, or dean, Rabbi Eliezer Waldman, reserve captain of an Israeli Defense Forces tank unit, and former Member of the Israeli Knesset.

The observant staff at Nir College is dedicated to building Jewish life the Torah way, by training up G-d fearing, battle-ready, proud Jewish young men to boldly and firmly lead Israel into the fullness of G-d's Purposes. All of Nir's students participate in an IDF officers' training program that fosters the Divine obligation to defend the Land by combining Torah studies with army service. This fruitful program continues to produce highly motivated and disciplined hesder boys whose total dedication to G-d and country make them well known among the IDF top brass. It is the hesder boys who serve in the elite units that make up the front lines of Israel's defense.

Nir College also prides itself in its Russian Olim program, which is geared toward helping new Russian immigrant students gain a solid foundation in basic Judaism, Hebrew, and Jewish values and philosophy. The home environment and camaraderie these boys enjoy at the Yeshiva help them to adjust to their new life in Israel, and this smooth transition is what encourages their families to also make Aliyah to the Land. Such programs ensure that Nir College graduates are well equipped to fill spiritual, educational, political and military leadership positions not only within Kiryat Arba and other established communities, but in new homesteads throughout the length and breadth of the Land, where future generations could be reared to carry on the Torah legacy.

As intense international pressure bears down upon the Jewish People for settling in and building up their Biblical Inheritance, construction continues without apology on the Nir campus. Right now the roof is being raised over the Project Shofar International Communications Center, a multi-functional facility that will house the Project Shofar headquarters, a media center, a convention hall and meeting rooms, a computerized monitoring station, and more classrooms. From this impressive complex, the Nir staff will greet new immigrants and tourists, who will learn about Biblical Zionism and Jewish Roots in

Eretz Yisra'el through multi-media presentations, tours and lectures. The center will be used in conjunction with its multi-purpose dormitories to host annual Christian pilgrimages to Hebron, which will facilitate seminars and roundtable discussions.

From his headquarters at the center, Project Shofar Executive Director Gary Cooperberg will keep Christians and Jews throughout the nations abreast of important issues and events impacting Israel. This networking will help pave the way for Mr. Cooperberg's Aliyah program, which will purpose to establish Jewish Identity/Emergency Evacuation Centers and Christian Divisions throughout the globe. These centers and divisions will link up to the Communication Center's monitoring station to report on the status of the Exiled Jewish communities. This will enable Mr. Cooperberg to track Aliyah movements and anti-Semitic flare-ups worldwide.

Jewish/volunteers versed in Judaism and in the complex Aliyah issues will staff the Jewish Identity Centers in order to implement preventative measures designed to actively encourage, educate and facilitate Jews in making Aliyah while time still permits.

Christian volunteers staffing the Christian Divisions will work on removing the political and financial barricades that historically frustrate Aliyah efforts. They will urge their policy-makers to accommodate Aliyah-based operations and develop pro-Israel policies, and they will raise funds within the Church, giving it an opportunity to be a strong support for Israel. Not only will these monies help to undergird the Yeshiva and the Jewish Identity Centers, they will also send Mr. Cooperberg out into the Exile to prod our Jewish brethren to return to the Land in preparation for the culmination of Redemption – before the hunters come.

The season that is upon us indicates time is short to accomplish these good deeds, which will bring glory to the G-d of all Creation. Nir College invites all those who understand the greatness of the hour that has come upon Mankind to come under the Project Shofar banner and support these holy endeavors.

May it be that we will all be found working diligently in the field when the Holy One ushers in the climax of Redemption and establishes the true New World Order.
